Airport Responsibilities Under the Multi-Sector Storm Water Permit



What is an Multi Sector Permit?

A Multi-Sector permit is an industrial permit that authorizes storm water runoff that exits any system that is used for collecting and conveying storm water that originates from manufacturing, processing, material storage, and waste material disposal areas

Who needs a Multi-Sector Permit?

A Multi-Sector TPDES Permit is required for specific type of industrial facilities. Airports are covered under Sector S, Air Transportation

How do you know if you need a Multi-Sector permit?

The requirements apply only to storm water discharges from those portions of airports that are involved in

- **vehicle (including aircraft) maintenance (including vehicle rehabilitation, mechanical repairs, painting, fueling and lubrication),**
- **equipment cleaning operations**
- **deicing operations.**



Multi-Sector - How Do I Get Out of it?

Conditional No Exposure Exclusion from Permit Requirements

- Facilities with industrial activities may be excluded from permit requirements if industrial activities and materials are isolated from rain, snow, snowmelt, and runoff by storm-resistant shelters.



Multi-Sector - How Do I Get Out of it?

Conditional No Exposure Exclusion from Permit Requirements

Examples of industrial activities include, but are not limited to:

fuel and oil storage

storage of raw materials

fueling, painting, de-icing, and maintenance of aircraft

NOTE: Because of safety issues, it is very difficult to get an exclusion for fuel storage

Conditional No Exposure Exclusion from Permit Requirements

If you believe your facility qualifies for this exemption, complete and submit the form Conditional No Exposure Certification (NEC) for Exclusion from the TPDES Multi-Sector General Permit

- (iii) The name of the receiving waters.
- (iv) The name of the municipal operator, if the discharge is through an MS4.

Contents of the Small Multi-Sector NOI

- (v) A certification that a SWP3 has been developed and implemented according to the provisions of this permit.
- (vi) The primary SIC code or Industrial Activity Code that best describes the industrial activity of the facility, and any other SIC codes that describe additional activities that are identified in the permit as requiring permit coverage.

- \$100 Application Fee with each NOI.

- \$100 Annual Waste Treatment Fee.

Will be billed to permit holders on September 1st of each year.

Storm Water Pollution Prevention Management Plan (SW3P)

Must Contain

1. Establish a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Team
2. Inspect facility for non-storm water flows
3. Describe potential pollutant sources
4. Describe pollution prevention measures and controls

SW3P

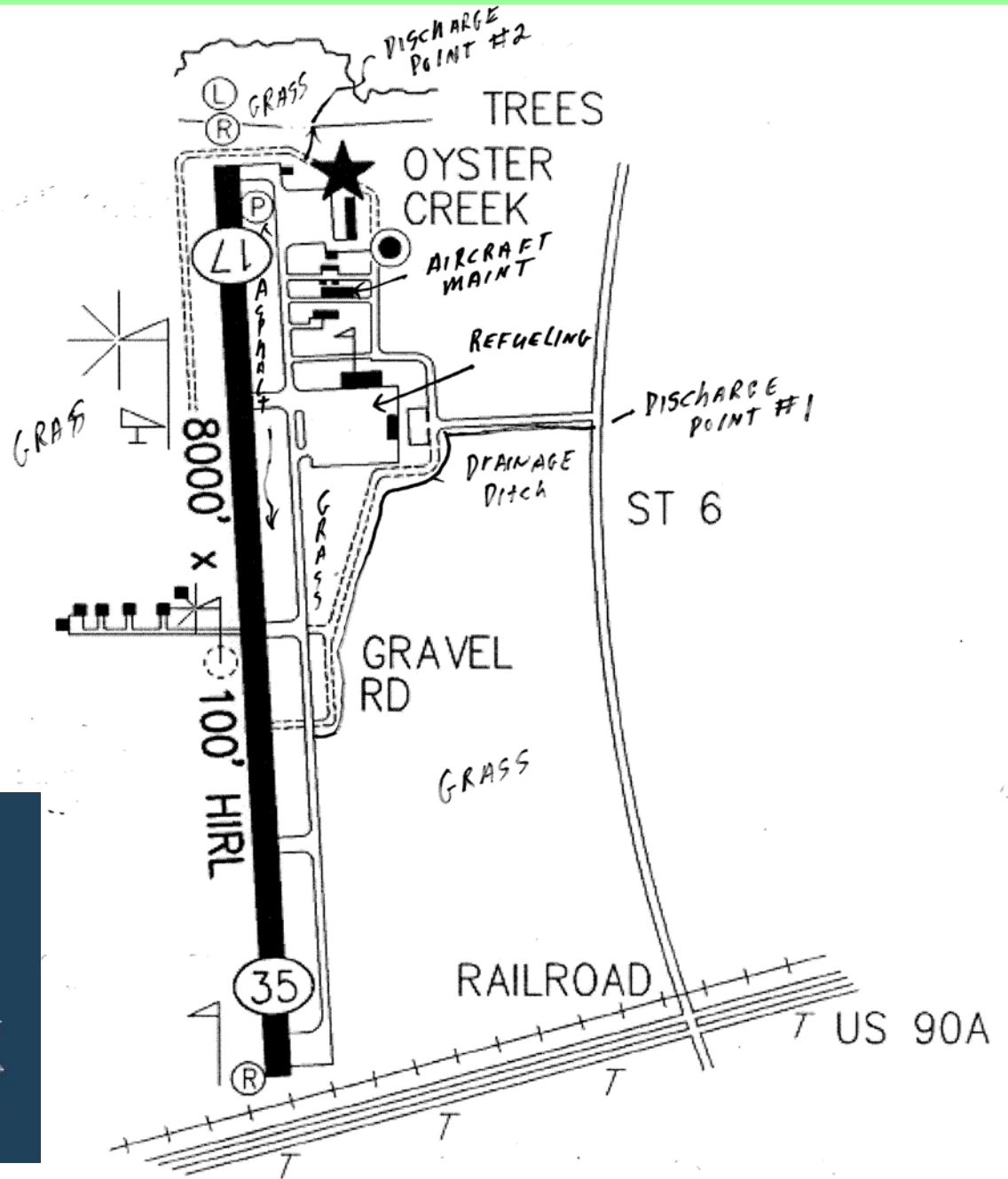
1. Establish a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Team
2. Inspect facility for non-storm water flows

Examples of non-storm water flows may include, but are not limited to, the following sources: process wastewater, aircraft, vehicle or equipment cleaning water, groundwater.

SW3P

3. Describe potential pollutant sources:

- (a) List an inventory of exposed materials.
- (b) Develop a narrative description of activities and sources that may contribute to storm water pollution.
- (c) Develop a site map.
- (d) List historical spills and leaks (including reportable quantity spills required by 30 TAC Chapter 327), and keep log of any additional spills and leaks.
- (e) Summarize all sampling data.



SW3P

4. Describe pollution prevention measures and controls, including:

- (a) Good housekeeping,
- (b) Spill Prevention/Response,
- (c) Erosion Control,
- (d) Maintenance program for structural controls,
- (e) Best management practices (BMPs) used to reduce pollutants in runoff,
- (f) Employee training and education programs,
- (g) Monitoring activities, and
- (h) Records of above.
